All nominations are showcased at the AWCI WA Awards Night to your industry peers. Winners are awarded with an engraved plaque on the evening and promotion on the AWCI media channels. Nominated state finalists are put forward into the AWCIANZ Trans-Tasman Excellence Awards categories.

Photography Tips

If you are taking your own photos, here are the top tips on getting the best shots of your work:

- Take photos during daylight hours for the best natural lighting. Turn on internal lights, if possible.
- Stand back to take photos of the full room showing from the floor to ceiling, and then take close up to show the details of your work
- Use a flat surface (i.e bench, tripod) to make sure your photos aren't tilted, blurred or shaky.
- Make sure that space is tidy and there are no people in the area. As a minimum, take photos with a high quality camera phone with clean lenses.
- Show off your work with photos taken at different angles.

FAQ's

- **My project will be completed soon, can I enter it in this year?**
Entries into the 2023 Awards are required to be completed and painted between July 2021 - July 2023
- **Can I put the same project in multiple categories?**
A project can be entered into a maximum of two categories if different structures are being evaluated e.g Domestic and Facade.
- **How many entries can I submit into one category?**
Companies can submit 3 entries only per category
- **Will the address of a residential entry be kept private?**
Residential projects are listed as "Suburb Residence" for display, e.g 'Coorparoo Residence'.

Conditions of Entry - Entries close 4th August 2023

ELIGIBILITY

- Entrants must be financial members of the AWCI at the time of entry until completion of the Awards program
- Forms must be fully completed and submitted with all relevant attachments
- Entrants agree to the condition of entry by submitting a nomination into the AWCI Excellence Awards
- The AWCI can cancel a category if there is only 3 or less entries submitted. A minimum of 4 entries per category must be submitted for that category to go ahead.

JUDGING

- Entries will be judged based on a combination of physical inspection (where applicable), the information provided in the entry form and accompanying material.
- Projects may be entered in up to two categories if the areas begin judged are completely separate with different judging criteria e.g internal/external
- The judging panel reserve the right to transfer an entry into a different division price/category than that originally entered into if deemed more suitable.
- The judging panel reserve the right to decline to present an award in a particular category if a minimum standard of excellence has not been met. The judging panel reserve the right to disqualify an entry at any time throughout the award program if deemed ineligible.
- The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

MEDIA

- The entrant is to obtain permission from the owner/builder for entry into the Excellence Awards and access for judging is required.
- All submissions material will be retained by the AWCI and may be used in published literature or promotional material. Originals will not be returned.
- All submission material including photographs do not infringe copyright for any other intellectual property right and the AWCI State Association and AWCI Australia and New Zealand Inc will be indemnified against such infringements.
